Who Should Attend?

D.C.s, Jt. D.C.s, Instructors, club-level Ratings Examiners, Sponsors, Parents, Pony Clubbers and friends.

Standards and Ratings Clinic Focus:

This clinic will give attendees a visual and verbal interpretation of the USPC Riding Standards D1 through C2 “on the flat” and “over fences.” Explanation and demonstration of terms, such as basic balanced position; independent seat; and, coordinated use of aids, will be given. Ms. Harmon will discuss these Standards as demonstrated by Pony Clubbers at each of the riding levels.

Cost: FREE – A \$50 Deposit is required to hold your place as a demonstration rider, but this deposit will be refunded after the clinic.

Sign-up: You need to sign up to be a demonstration rider. Volunteers are needed to assist with jump set-up on Friday evening and tear-down on Sunday evening.
