What is a Standards & Ratings Clinic?

The purpose of this clinic is to develop consistency in our Region by familiarizing the examiners we use with the USPC Standards. We will be observing and evaluating differences in each rating and discussing how to set up successful ratings. We will be using demo riders for the D1 to C2 levels. We will also work on clarifying our teaching goals for instructors who are prepping candidates for ratings.

Any instructor who is prepping candidates for ratings, examiners in our region conducting club-level tests from D1 to the C2, Club DC, Jt. DC, and upper-level Pony Clubbers (C2 and up)
